

By the first day of January, April, July, and October, the EPIC board of education shall establish the number of transfer students EPIC has the capacity to accept in each grade level for each school site within EPIC and shall publish that capacity in a prominent place on the EPIC website and shall report to the State Department of Education the number of transfer students for each grade level for each school site within EPIC the district has the capacity to accept. 70 O. S. § 8-101.2 (2021)
