RE: Parents' Right to Know

In accordance with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Epic Charter Schools must notify every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive information in a timely manner regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers. The information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers shall include the following:

- If the teacher meets State qualifications and licensing requirements for the grade level and subject taught;
- If the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status in which the State qualifications and licensing criteria are waived;
- If the teacher holds certification in the area he/she is providing instruction; and
- Whether your child receives services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

Epic Charter Schools offers individualized instruction to each student. A certified teacher is assigned to each student and works in partnership with the family to teach, coach, and motivate each child. By design, certified teachers teach across all grade spans and subject areas, this means the teacher will not be certified in all subject areas offered. If you would like to receive specific information about your child's teacher or paraprofessional, please contact your school principal.

You also have the right to request and receive information regarding any State or district policy on student participation on assessments.
